We believe in a flexible approach to care, which means our midwives, in conjunction with your Obstetrician, will support and encourage you, within a family centred caring environment. We aim to provide you and your baby with the best personalised care and attention during your stay.

Your accommodation

We have pleasure in offering private rooms with ensuite facilities, television and phone.

Menus provide nutritious and appetising meals and special requirements are catered for on request. For a small charge, your partner is welcome to join you for a meal.

Light snacks and drinks are also available at our kiosk.

Nursery

Our Level Two Nursery is fully equipped to meet the needs of sick and premature babies. It is staffed by experienced midwives, skilled in the care of newborn babies. Paediatricians provide 24-hour coverage.

Education services

When preparing for that special arrival, we recommend that if you are expecting your first baby you take part in our Antenatal Education Program. All antenatal classes are conducted by qualified childbirth educators.

During your hospital stay you will be provided with an education booklet and have supported education by the maternity nursing staff. Fathers are welcome to be involved in the daily routine and education associated with caring for a new baby.

Visiting

Visiting hours are between 11am - 1pm and 4pm - 8pm daily. To ensure our new mothers receive adequate rest, we restrict all calls and visitors during the rest period 1pm - 4pm.

Booking into the hospital

Please call the toll free number (1800 813 071) to the patient service centre Monday – Friday (7am to 8.30pm) to book into the hospital when you are around 10 – 14 weeks pregnant. This call confirms your doctor's booking and at the same time all personal and financial details are discussed. There are no longer any complicated forms to complete.

- Pharmaceutical Benefits Card* (*if applicable)

Please be advised that this phone call will take approximately 10 – 20 minutes. If you are hearing impaired, or speak another language, please arrange for someone to assist you with the call.

At the completion of this call, please ask to be transferred to Maternity if you wish to book antenatal classes.

Due to the high demand for the antenatal classes it is strongly recommended you book at this time to avoid disappointment.
